<u>Election Procedure:</u> Person(s) Is/Are Nominated, the Nomination Does Not Require a Second. Votes are cast for each nominee. Vice-Mayor is elected by majority vote. A single nominee is elected by acclamation.

4. Call for Nominations for Office of Secretary-Treasurer and Election to That Office

<u>Election Procedure:</u> Person(s) Is/Are Nominated, the Nomination Does Not Require a Second. Votes are cast for each nominee. Secretary-Treasurer is elected by majority vote. A single nominee is elected by acclamation.
