

Former Key West official could lose home's Certificate of Occupancy

The City of Key West is moving to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy for the Harris Avenue home of former Chief Building Official Rajindhar "Raj" Ramsingh, whose alleged misconduct in the role remains under investigation.

On Tuesday, June 17, the city sent a certified letter to Ramsingh and his wife, Deborah Ramsingh, notifying them of significant permitting and inspection issues at their property at 2827 Harris Ave. According to the letter, acting Chief Building Official and licensed Building Code Administrator Ronald W. Wampler reviewed the property's permit history and found multiple violations, including incomplete inspections and concealed work.
