

Vote-by-Mail Ballot Request

Under Florida law, all registered voters are permitted to vote by mail. The KCB ordinance on early voting does not apply to voting by mail.

This request is for the KCB Referendum Election only

You may request a vote-by-mail ballot in person, by mail, email, fax or by phone. Only the voter or a designated member of his or her immediate family or legal guardian can request a vote-by-mail ballot for the voter. Immediate family means the designee's spouse, parent, child, grandparent or sibling of the designee or of the designee's spouse.
